MILE HIGH CHAPTER CHOIR TO PLAY VAIL FARMERS MARKET

Don't miss soulful gospel music from noon to 3:30pm on Sunday, July 12

Vail, CO July 10, 2008 – A dozen of Denver's finest gospel singers will travel to Vail on Sunday, July 12 to share their soulful gospel music ministry at the Vail Farmers' Market. Always a favorite, the Mile High Chapter Choir, the preeminent gospel choir in Denver, is slated to perform on the Vail Jazz Festival stage on Meadow Drive near Annie's.

The Mile High Chapter Choir was established in Denver in 1993 to minister sacred music to reach the hearts of people everywhere. The all-star chorale group includes singers hailing from 12 Denver area churches, who perform in their own churches and together in both religious and secular settings throughout the region.

"Mile High Chapter Choir has been an essential element of the Vail Jazz Festival for over 10 years," said Mia Vlaar, executive director of the Vail Jazz Foundation. Gary Thornton, who regularly volunteers for the Vail Jazz Festival continued, "The music draws you in – it's a hand-clapping, rousing old time sound that make you want to get up and dance."

"Jazz has its roots in gospel music," said Howard Stone, Vail Jazz Foundation chair and artistic director. "It all started at Congo Square in New Orleans, where the African rhythms were first blended with traditional European church music." Add call and response, percussion and dancing, and eventually instrumentation, and the music evolved to a point where it started taking on a life of its own -- The Blues, Jazz, and more.

The Choir works in association with the largest gospel association in the world, the Gospel Music Workshop of America (GMWA), which was established over 40 years ago to nurture gospel vocalists and instrumentalists in the United States and beyond. The GMWA hosts an annual conference for 30,000 vocalists and musicians from all over the United States, and the UK, Italy, Japan, Canada and Germany.

The Choir will return to Vail to play in Vail Square on September 6 as part of the Labor Day Weekend Jazz Party. For tickets or more information, contact the Vail Jazz Foundation at 970.479.6146.
