

Vail Jazz 2023: Solaris Venue FAQ

Free Sunday afternoon concerts return to Solaris Plaza for the second year! As this is still a relatively new venue to the Festival, we'd like to provide guidance and help patrons to know what to expect.

Question: Will there be seating?

Answer: There is no seating on the plaza at Solaris. Seating for dining is available at DECA + BOL and other local restaurants (reservations recommended) and there is room for open seating on the terraced stairs surrounding the plaza. Limited VIP seating is available – contact bethany@vailjazz.org for information.

Question: What can I bring to the venue?

Answer: If you wish to bring a chair, please bring a low chair to be mindful of others behind you. Coolers and food are permitted. Outside alcohol is not permitted. Food and alcohol are available for purchase at DECA + BOL. Please do not bring your pets on the turf.

Question: What if there is inclement weather?

Answer: The performance will go on rain or shine. Lightning may cause a delay or cancellation. There is no covered seating, and mountain summers are unpredictable so please be prepared with sunscreen, rain gear and layers.

Question: Where can I park?

Answer: Free parking is available at the Vail Village Parking Structure, located a quarter mile from Solaris Plaza. Paid parking is available at the Solaris parking structure. The venue is located on the free town bus route.

Question: Is the venue ADA accessible?

Answer: Although there is no designated accessible area on the turf, there are many accessible vantage points in this public space. Elevators are located in both the Vail Village and Solaris parking structures.
